

MIRACLE SHILOHS EAR GLUING INSTRUCTIONS

ALL ABOUT EARS!!!



Even though we "love them just the same" even if their ears never come up, **NOBODY** likes to see a Shiloh with soft ears! So, we will do everything in our power to help you get your baby's ears UP! These two lovely Tella granddaughters were born in 2002. Can you tell which owners followed our instructions about gluing ears and which did not? *Of course you can!*



INSTRUCTIONS FOR GLUING YOUR PUPPY'S EARS:

1. Go to your local fabric store, and purchase a tube of fabric glue (we use/recommend a product called SpeedSew, which is available in the fabric department at WalMart in Canada). Another product people have used successfully is a craft and leather glue called Tear Mender.
2. Place a line of glue along the inside edge of each ear (*Photo 1*)
(Note: You want to glue fur-to-fur, not skin-to-skin.)
Hold the ears up, and blow on the ears until the glue becomes "tacky."
Place and hold the ears together, until the glue sticks (*Photo 2*)
3. Once the glue has adhered, remove your hand, and *voila* --- erect ears! (*Photo 3*)
4. When the glue wears away and the ears separate:
 - * If the ears are not standing, re-glue them immediately! You may have to do this a few times.
 - * If the ears stand for a couple of days, then start to droop, re-glue them!
 - * If the ears are standing, and they remain standing and solid... you're finished!
5. Do not remove extra glue from the ears. If you must re-glue, you can affix glue to glue.
